Notice to Mariners No. 24 of 2023 Escorted Vessel Movements

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that large vessels, vessels constrained by draught and vessels restricted in their ability to manoeuvre regularly navigate within the Falmouth Harbour area. These vessels require unobstructed passage of the fairway, and other vessels are required to keep out of the way under the International Collision Regulations and Falmouth Harbour Byelaws.

Vessels requiring unobstructed passage of the fairway will normally be escorted by Falmouth Harbour Pilot Boats and/or Patrol Vessels, exhibiting blue flashing lights. All vessels should keep well clear of these movements and follow any instructions given by vessels exhibiting blue flashing lights.

Vessels typically used for escorting movements include:

**Pilot Vessel ARROW****Pilot Vessel L K MITCHELL****Patrol Vessel KILLIGREW**
