NOTICE OF DIRECTION

HARBOUR DIRECTION 01/16

Notice is Hereby Given that the Commissioners of Falmouth Harbour, a Designated Harbour pursuant to The Harbour Directions (Designation of Harbour Authorities) Order 2015 intend to make, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 40A of the Harbours Act 1964, the following direction in respect of vessels navigating in the proximity of Gyllyngvase, Castle and Swanpool beaches.

Every Ship navigating within the Area to landward of a line from Pendennis Point to Penance Point and within 250 metres of Mean Low Water Mark from the 1st of May to the 30th September annually must, unless otherwise authorised by the Harbour Master in writing, be navigated at a speed not exceeding 4 knots through the water.

Harbour Direction 01/15 made by the Commissioners in exercise of its powers under the Harbour Directions (Designation of Harbour Authorities) Order 2015 that was in force immediately before the making of this direction is revoked.

Note.

- a. "ship", includes every description of vessel used in navigation, seaplanes on the surface of the water and hovercraft within the meaning of the Hovercraft Act 1968; [section 57 the Harbour Act 1964].
- b. The master of a ship must ensure that harbour directions are complied with. [Section 40C (1) the Harbours Act 1964].
- c. Breach of section 40C (1) without reasonable excuse is an offence. [Section 40C (2) the Harbours Act 1964].
