NOTICE OF DIRECTION

HARBOUR DIRECTION 2/19

Notice is Hereby Given that the Commissioners of Falmouth Harbour, a Designated Harbour pursuant to The Harbour Directions (Designation of Harbour Authorities) Order 2015 intend to make, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 40A of the Harbours Act 1964, the following direction in respect of vessels navigating in the Carrick Roads.

Unless permitted in writing by the Harbour Master, no ship navigating in the Fal Estuary to Westward of a line drawn from the end of the Eastern Jetty to Trefusis Headland and passing through Tom Brown Rock (Charted feature) and within the Jurisdiction of Falmouth Harbour Commissioners shall exceed a speed of 6kts.

Note.

- a. "ship", includes every description of vessel used in navigation, seaplanes on the surface of the water and hovercraft within the meaning of the Hovercraft Act 1968; [section 57 the Harbour Act 1964].
- b. The master of a ship must ensure that harbour directions are complied with. [Section 40C (1) the Harbours Act 1964].
- c. Breach of section 40C (1) without reasonable excuse is an offence. [Section 40C (2) the Harbours Act 1964].
