



Harbour Charges

Transiting Harbour Area to/from Falmouth Docks

Following a recent request, the following guidance is offered relating to Harbour Charges associated with the transiting of vessels to and from *Falmouth Docks*; vessel operators' and agents' attention are drawn to the following:

- For the purposes of this Notice, the following rates currently apply:
 - Rate A = £0.021 per GT
 - Rate B = £0.108 per GT
- Vessels of more than 50GT using Falmouth Bay area where minimum services are provided may do so for up to 28 days at Rate A. For extended stays, Rate A will be re-charged every 28 days.
- Vessels of more than 50GT using the Carrick Roads can remain for up to 24 hours at Rate A. Thereafter Rate B will be applied, which is re-chargeable every 28 days.
- Vessels of more than 50GT entering and leaving Falmouth Docks within a 24-hour period will be charged at Rate A (except for delivery tankers to the Eastern Jetty which are always charged at Rate B, reflecting counter-pollution costs).
- Vessels of more than 50GT entering and leaving Falmouth Docks within a 28-day period will be charged at Rate B, which includes all movements (for example, sea trials) undertaken within that period.
- Vessels entering Falmouth Docks and departing more than 28 days later will be charged at Rate B to cover the first 28 days and Rate A on departure.
- Vessels on passage to Truro or Lay-Up Berths will be charged at Rate A for each transit. If they transit twice within the same 24-hour period only one charge will be levied.

This guidance is to be read in conjunction with the annual published harbour charges
