## **PORT NOTICE TO MARINERS**

### **NO. 10a of 2016**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Plymouth – Falmouth - Fowey - Plymouth Triangle race will take place over the weekend 30<sup>th</sup> April to 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2016.

Yachts will depart Plymouth and arrive in Falmouth on 30<sup>th</sup> April approximately between 1200 and 1700.

The finish line will be the transit formed between ‘The Governor’ east cardinal buoy (50deg 09.15’N 005deg 01.83’W) at the starboard end of the finish line and a finish committee yacht displaying an orange flag at the port end.

The Falmouth to Fowey leg will depart on Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> May with the first class scheduled to start at about 1025, the other two classes following at 10 minute intervals.

The start line will be the transit formed by the PoFSA flagstaff on the foreshore at Pendennis Point displaying an orange flag, and Black Rock Beacon.

Mariners are requested to navigate with particular caution during this period and are reminded of Falmouth Harbour Bye-Law 13 [www.falmouthport.co.uk/pdf/bye-laws.pdf](http://www.falmouthport.co.uk/pdf/bye-laws.pdf) which requires masters of small craft to avoid obstructing or impeding racing vessels.
