NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Turbo Asymmetric Open & RS200 Cornish Championships will take place on 4th – 5th September 2021. Racing will take place in the Carrick Roads with craft based out of Restronguet sailing club. Racing may cover both Falmouth and Truro harbour waters.

Mariners are requested to navigate with particular caution during this period and are reminded of Falmouth Harbour Bye-Law 13, which requires masters of small craft to avoid obstructing or impeding racing vessels:

The starting line will be between the mast displaying the orange flag on the race committee boat and a mark with an orange flag at the port end.

The finishing line will be between the mast displaying a blue flag on the committee boat and a mark with an orange flag.
