PORT NOTICE TO MARINERS

NO. 20 of 2020

FALMOUTH WEEK SAILING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Sailing Races will be held in Falmouth Bay and in Carrick Roads from Wednesday 12th August to Saturday 15th August inclusive.

The courses will be set on the day according to the prevailing conditions. The start line for the Carrick fleet will be a line from Pendennis Point towards Black Rock beacon. The start line for the bay fleet will be a line from Hine Downing Mark to the committee boat. There will be approximately 30-40 boats in the Bay and 50 -60 boats in Carrick Roads.

For marks see port notice 16 of 2020, it should be noted that marks 'Bay', 'Central', 'Helston' and 'Old Wall' which are normally laid and recovered daily will be in position from Tuesday until Sunday.

Racing will take place late morning to late afternoon; it is expected there will be 1 long race Wednesday and two shorter races on the other days with option for a third on Saturday.

Safety Co-ordinator Carrick fleet VHF Ch. 69 call 'Safety Control'.
Bay fleet C committee boat VHF Ch. 72 call 'Bay Committee'.

Mariners are requested to navigate with particular caution during this period and are reminded of Falmouth Harbour Bye-Law 13 <https://www.falmouthharbour.co.uk/wp/wp-content/uploads/30-130-01-FHC-Byelaws.pdf> which requires masters of small craft to avoid obstructing or impeding racing vessels.

Commercial craft, warships and auxiliaries are requested to call Falmouth Pilots on VHF CH 09 before entering port limits to determine large vessel movements in relation to regatta courses set on the day.
