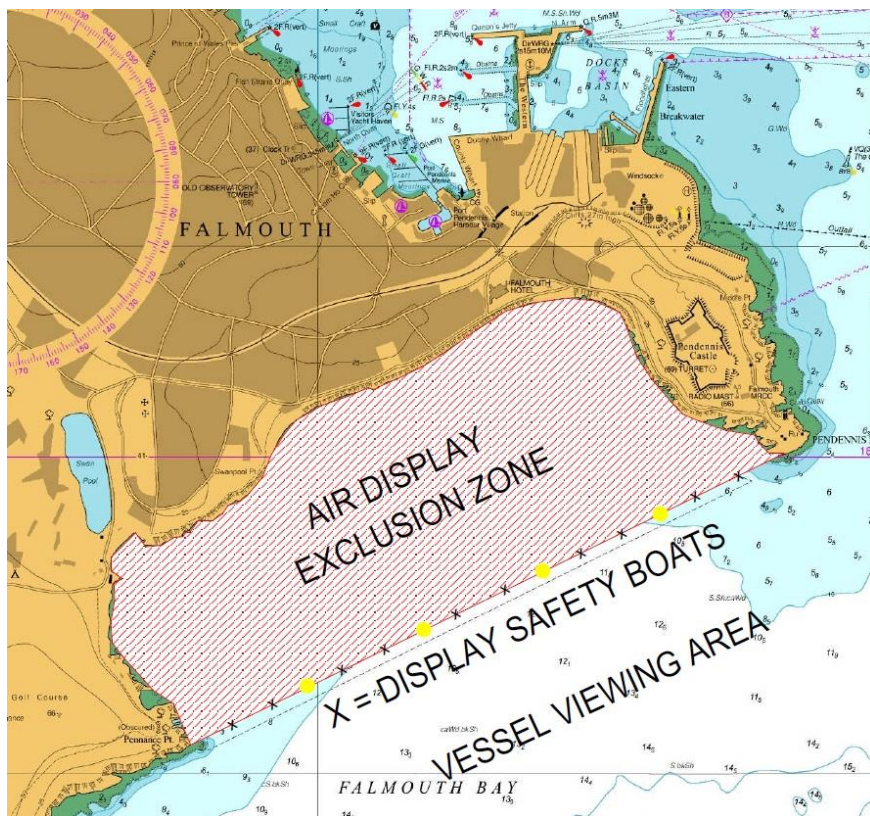
PORT NOTICE TO MARINERS

NO. 21 OF 2019

AIR DISPLAY RESTRICTIONS IN FALMOUTH BAY ON WEDNESDAY 14TH AUGUST 2019 FROM 17:00 HRS BST

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that an aerobatics display will take place over Falmouth Bay at 17:45 on Wednesday 14th August 2019.

To comply with the current display regulations, a safety zone will be in force between the beach shorelines and a marked line of four high visible pillar buoys and a number of safety boats between Pendennis Point and Penance Point. **In order for the display to take place, the exclusion zone must be clear of all waterborne craft from 17:00 until completion of the display, which should be 18:45.**

Mariners are directed (**Harbour Direction 01/19 is attached**) to remain clear of the safety zone from 17:00 on the day of the display. The Northern and Southern boundaries of the zone will be patrolled by authorised craft displaying conspicuous flags and mariners are required to co-operate with instructions given by these vessels.

All commercial shipping movements in Falmouth Bay zone C will be suspended from 1700. All vessels positioned for viewing the display in Falmouth Bay are requested to remain stationary during the display to reduce the risk of collision..

NOTICE OF DIRECTION

HARBOUR DIRECTION 01/19

Air Display Exclusion Zone

Notice is Hereby Given that the Commissioners of Falmouth Harbour, a Designated Harbour pursuant to The Harbour Directions (Designation of Harbour Authorities) Order 2015 intend to make, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 40A of the Harbours Act 1964, the following direction in respect of vessels in the proximity of Gyllyngvase, Castle and Swanpool beaches Falmouth.

All ships are prohibited from entering or remaining within the Area to landward of a line drawn from Pendennis Point to Penance Point from 17.00hrs Wednesday 14th August 2019 to 19.00hrs the same day unless otherwise authorised by the Harbour Master in writing.

Note.

- a. "ship", includes every description of vessel used in navigation, seaplanes on the surface of the water and hovercraft within the meaning of the Hovercraft Act 1968; [section 57 the Harbour Act 1964].
- b. The master of a ship must ensure that harbour directions are complied with. [Section 40C (1) the Harbours Act 1964].
- c. Breach of section 40C (1) without reasonable excuse is an offence. [Section 40C (2) the Harbours Act 1964].
- d. For identification purposes a chart of the area is annexed.
